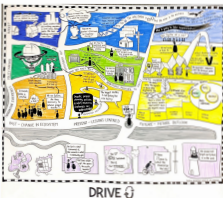
COOPERATION

Drive 0 project Final Symposium and Clustering Workshop

The PLURAL project actively participated at the **Drive 0** project Final Symposium and Clustering Workshop titled: *Fostering experiences from EU innovation projects to accelerate a sustainable built environment*.

The workshop took place at the European Committee of the Regions in Brussels on Wednesday 15th of November 2023. And was organized in collaboration with our sister projects **STEPUP**, **INFINITE** and **BuMUPspeed**, **GigaFegaFactory**.

The PLURAL project coordinator, **Marie Fourné**, presented experiences and lessons learnt from the project, supporting the industrialization of prefabricated construction. The event's outcomes were depicted in a comprehensive graphic showing the past-present-future outlook of off-site, modular, prefabricated construction.

Switch2Save project Final Workshop

The PLURAL project participated in a workshop held in Athens on September 20th as part of the final meeting of the **Switch2Save** project. Two presentations that shed light on essential aspects of our project's outcomes were included: *"Lessons Learned Towards Industrialization of Active Components"* and *"Switch2Save Contribution to the Revision of SET Plan of Active Facades"*.

One of the highlights of the workshop was the opportunity for participants to visit the NTUA Living Lab. Here, they were introduced to real-time monitoring and the impressive results achieved so far from the Switch2Save EC-TE Insulating Glass Units and the PLURAL SmartWall.

DEMO SITE IN KAŠAVA, CZECH REPUBLIC



In August 2023 the construction company began preparatory work on the Kašava demonstration site. From excavations around the house to waterproofing repairs of the underground structure, solid steps towards the installation of the **Canik Wall** were taken.

By November 2023, the roof had been removed and the space for installing iron anchors in the lower part of the building was being prepared. This was a significant step in ensuring that everything was set up for the installation.

In June 2023, pre-reconstruction monitoring at the Kašava building was initiated, installing sensors that cover three main areas of interest: indoor air quality, energy consumption, and weather conditions.
